Figure 5 (§3.1.1): Number of gestalt features in purpose clauses (N = 218)




Figure 7 (§3.2.1): Number of languages with balanced, deranked or mixed purpose clauses, per macro-area




Figure 10 (§3.4.1): Primary gestalt features in purpose clauses (N=225)




Figure 14 (§3.4.1): Phonological (syllable) structure of different types of primary markers




Figure 15. Secondary gestalt features in purpose clauses (N=218)




Figure 19 (§3.5.1): Preferred positioning patterns of purpose clauses (N=80)




Figure 22 (§3.5.2): Position of the primary marker ('subordinator') in the purpose clause (N=225)
